**Additional Financial Information:**

We need an average of **\$2,000 weekly** or **\$8,700 monthly** to meet *budgeted* 2021 expenses. Our budget shows monthly income of \$7,000 (or \$1,600 weekly), which results in a budgeted shortfall. Our goal is to become self-sustaining, which requires an **additional \$1,700 monthly (\$400 weekly)**.
